Harmony Heartland Region 4's first Mixed Harmony Quartet Contest is intended to be a light –hearted musical escape for both competitors and audience members alike. Let your imagination run wild with eye-catching props, eccentric emcee scripts and creatively orchestrated chords. This shot at something spectacular is a first for all of us; we cannot wait to cheer you on!

- Mixed Harmony Quartet Contest competitors will compete in groups that have four members.
- A mixed quartet is a vocal quartet, which includes members of more than one gender, in any combination.
- Music performed will reflect the barbershop style of performance and /or similar four-part a cappella harmony.
- Performers will have one center microphone on a mic stand.
- Performance content will be suitable for general audiences.
- Total performance length will be a maximum of 6 minutes.
- Mixed quartet entries will be limited to 6 quartets.
- The use of props is acceptable. Competitors must carry their props on and off stage.
- Once the draw for order of appearance is completed, competitors must adhere to their assigned on stage time.
- Competitors will receive scoresheets written by Sweet Adelines Judges utilizing the criteria in the Open Division category.
