Welcome and Agenda Review

Sue welcomed all to the Zoom meeting – All were in attendance.

NEW BUSINESS

April 2020 Region Convention/Contest – SAI cancelled all region contests in March.

- Beverly shared an Expense Spreadsheet to RMT. The Marriott is to be paid by April 18th which
 is the last outstanding bill. She is working with all the Chorus Treasurers to get information on
 best way to handle reimbursements of AET's. Reimbursements will be at a reduced amount to
 help offset PayPal fees. If members elect to donate their AET fee to the region the tax donation
 letter provided to them will be at the full amount for the member to report on their 2020 taxes.
- Natalie will be evaluating the Hotel Room Blocks for next year's contest ASAP. We are still waiting on the contract from the hotels for the 2026 Contest.
- Sue sent a formal request for financial assistance to International and we have gotten a
 response that they received it and are evaluating all requests and will respond with an answer
 as soon as possible.
- A Region Financial Status report will be sent to RMT once it is determined how much of the AET funds are donated and what SAI will be providing to the region for support. Target for this report is the end of April per Beverly.

June 2020 Leadership Workshop – Postponed to July 17 & 18 tentatively.
