Dear Judy:

Paulette Hataloshy and Sherry Palmer asked that I send the Directors Certification Program Evaluations to you so that they can continue their testing in the program. The evaluations are a very important part of the program which the International Education Direction has developed to measure the level of achievement for participants in the program.

I am asking that you, as chapter president, monitor the evaluation process for the following enclosed skill areas for both Paulette and Sherry:

SKILL AREA IV:

TEACHING SKILLS/PART I

SKILL AREA V:

MANAGEMENT SKILLS

SKILL AREA VIII:

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

SKILL AREA X: REHEARSAL PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION
A copy of each area is enclosed. You will need to make 23 additional copies of each form so that each evaluator will have a set of forms. The procedure and instructions are as follows:

- 1. The evaluation "team" for Paulette will consist of six board members selected by you, the president, and six additional chorus members selected by Paulette. (You may be one of the 12 selected.) You should advise the chorus members selected of the purpose and importance of these evaluations and instruct them to evaluate each item. The same procedure should be done with Sherry...evaluators may be the same or different members...Paulette and Sherry should not be one of the evaluators. You may want to do the evaluations on two different nights so that evaluators will be able to focus on each individual candidate.
- 2. The evaluation should be held at a time and place that provides privacy. It may be held prior to or immediately following a chorus rehearsal. Paulette should not be in the room while the her evaluation forms are being completed and Sherry should not be in the room while her evaluation forms are being completed.
- 3. You should distribute an evaluation form for each skill area to each of the 12 selected chorus members then collect them as soon as they are completed. To assure the evaluators, Paulette, and Sherry that the comments <u>are</u> confidential, place the completed forms in an envelope and seal the envelope in the presence of the evaluation "team".

Welcome to the DCP Program!! As a participant you will receive information during the year concerning testing and special classes. There are requirements for advancement in the DCP Program and the following is a summary of these requirements:

LEVEL I - APPLICANT DIRECTOR

Requirements:

- a. Applicant must be a member of Sweet Adelines International, or a nonmember director of a Sweet Adelines International chorus or prospective chapter.
- b. Submit completed application form and application fee to International Headquarters.
- c. Complete self-evaluation form and return to DMA.

LEVEL II - APPROVED DIRECTOR

NOTE: All requirements for advancement must be completed after 5/1/89.

a. Completion of Self-Evaluation form.

b. Completion of the evaluations for all 10 of the following skill areas with a combined score of at least 50 points, as recorded on the annual Progress Report completed by the DMA.

- c. Attendance at a regional director education training session or an International Chorus Directors Seminar within the last 12 months.
- d. Advancement to the Approved Director will be supervised and approved by the DMA.

LEVEL III - CERTIFIED DIRECTOR

NOTE: All requirements for advancement must be completed after 5/1/89.

- a. Must be currently serving as director, assistant director, or associate director of a Sweet Adelines International chorus.
- b. Completion of Self-Evaluation form.
- c. Attendance at a regional director education training session or an International Chorus Directors Seminar within the last 12 months.
- d. Successful completion of the evaluations for all 10 of the skill areas, as follows:
 - A total score of at least 66 points in all 10 areas, with a minimum score of 4 points in each area.
 - 2. A score of at least 40 points in the six (6) Musical/Technical areas and a score of at least 26 points in the four (4) Management/Communication areas.
- e. Advancement to the level of Certified Director will be determined by the Chorus Directors Coordinators with approval by the Education Direction Committee, based on information provided by the DMA. (NOTE: Information must be received at Int'l Headquarters by December 15.)

LEVEL IV - MASTER DIRECTOR

NOTE: All requirements for advancement must be completed after 5/1/89. The following additional requirements must be met for advancement to the level of Master Director:

- a. The director/participant must have achieved the level of Certified Director.
- b. The director must direct a chorus in competition that achieves a minimum of 600 points in a regional or international (1,200 points) chorus competition.
- c. Advancement to the level of Master Director will be determined by the Chorus Director Coordinators with approval by the Education Director Committee based on information provided by the DMA and recommendations by the Chorus Director Coordinators. (NOTE: Information must be received at International Headquarters by December 15 for review in February.)
