It's been a busy month...

Accomplished:

- Attended the Competition Team meeting at Singing Summit what a great group of hardworking folks!
- Assisted Melissa Marksbury-Roe in developing and presenting the Membership break-out session at Singing Summit. We had good attendance, and a lot of great discussion!
