Description of Regional Competition Awards

Joyce Doll Most Improved Quartet Award — Presented for the first time in 1997, this award was donated by the former Seven Hills Chorus, now a part of Cincinnati Sound Chorus, in memory of Joyce Doll, lead of the 1996 champion quartet, Crescendo!, and longtime member of Seven Hills Chorus. It is presented to the quartet showing the greatest increase in score since the previous contest. Quartets must have competed in the 2007 competition. To be considered the same

quartet, at least three members must be the same as in the previous contest.

Ruth Doll Novice Quartet Award — The former Seven Hills Chorus, , now a part of Cincinnati Sound Chorus, in memory of Ruth Doll, lead of the 1966 International Champion quartet, Piper-Ettes, and longtime member of Seven Hills Chorus, donated this award. (Ruth was Joyce Doll's mother.) It is presented to the highest-scoring quartet having at least three members who have never competed.

Novice Director Recognition — The Gem City Novice Director Award was retired in 2002. Since that time the Regional Management Team decided to recognize each novice director during a special presentation during the Regional Awards portion of the Afterglow. We applaud the outstanding and unique contribution directors bring to their choruses and their missions, the region, and the future of our organization.
